Background: The NERACOOS Annual Meeting is a yearly one-day event which serves to highlight ocean observing and modeling efforts in the region. This year marks the 10-year anniversary of the NERACOOS observing system. To celebrate the past, present, and future of ocean observing in the Northeast, we would like to hear how these data and information impacted people's lives, research, and decisions.

We are one of eleven regions of the U.S. Integrated Ocean Observing System with a mission to produce, integrate and communicate high quality information that helps ensure safety, economic and environmental resilience, and sustainable use of the coastal ocean. Founded in 2008, NERACOOS works with regional partners to make observations, run models, manage data and engage with end-users to deliver an end-to-end observing system.
